

## **Voting Equipment Public Logic and Accuracy Test**

In accordance with Florida Statute, Section 101.5612, a pre-election test of the automatic tabulating equipment, which will be used to tabulate the votes cast in the **November 3, 2020, General Election**, will begin at **10:30 a.m. on October 12, 2020** at the Supervisor of Elections Office, 16 South Madison Street, Quincy.

The purpose of the test is to ascertain that the equipment will correctly count the votes cast for all candidates and races.

The Canvassing Board will convene and begin testing the voting equipment until completed. Testing is open to all candidates, representatives of political parties, the press, and the public.

## **Canvass of Vote by Mail Returns**

The canvassing of the Returned Vote by Mail (absentee) ballots for the 2020 General Election, will take place at the Supervisor of Elections Office, at the following times:

- October 30, 2020 -10:30 a.m., Canvass of remaining Vote By Mail Ballots
- November 3, 2020 -3:00 p.m., Canvass of remaining Vote By Mail Ballots
- November 5, 2020 - 5:00 p.m., Canvass of Provisional & Cured Ballots
- November 13, 2020 -3:00 p.m., Canvass of Overseas Ballots
